## PARK RULES

In order to provide quality recreation experiences to all visitors at these extremely popular State Parks please follow these simple rules:

1. The use of alcoholic beverages is prohibited at Big Lake North, Big Lake South and Rocky Lake Campgrounds. ***Offenders may be fined \$60.00 and will be asked to leave the campground.***
2. Each vehicle parked overnight within the park will be charged a \$20.00 per night –per site camping fee. ***DAV Pass holders will not be charged Camping fees.***
3. **Check In**-Campers will have access to reserved and un-reserved sites as available.
4. **Check Out**-Campers will vacate campsites by no later than 12:00pm. Campers will be charged a minimum \$20.00 fee for each designated camping site occupied after 12:00pm.
5. Day Use hours are 7:00 A.M. To 10:00 P.M. Day users, including Boat Launch users, must exit the park by 11 :00 P.M., or pay the camping fee.
6. Quiet hours are enforced from 11:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M. Generators, stereos, and loud noises are prohibited. During this time, all motorized watercraft entering or leaving the bay at Big Lake North must operate at speeds of 5 MPH or less.
7. No wake zones extend from the shoreline out to 300 feet in front of the launch, swim beach and boat mooring beach, and 100 feet round the entire shoreline of the north bay.
8. Pets must be kept on a leash of 9 feet or less and kept under control of a person at all times.
9. The Discharge of Firearms is Prohibited within the Big Lake Area Parks. ***Offenders will be fined up to \$300.00 and will be asked to leave the campground.***
10. ALL Fireworks are Prohibited within the Big Lake Area Parks. ***Offenders will be fined up to \$200.00, and will be asked to leave the campground.***
11. The burning of Pallets, Cans, Bottles, food items and Baby Diapers in fire pits is Prohibited.
12. Swimmers are **NOT** allowed to swim on the Boat Launch or from the Boat Dock. ***Offenders will be asked to leave the Park.***
13. **7-Day Camping Limit**
14. **Limit 7 people per site**

**Premium Camping** fees apply to all Camping sites marked with a “P” in all facilities where applicable.

**Camping** is defined as persons staying overnight, 10:00pm – 7:00am, in vehicle(s) or space(s) within the boundary of the facility.

**Day Use** is defined as persons driving into the facility between the hours of 7:00am – 10:00pm. Applies to use of the facility for all passenger vehicles and trailers between 7:00am and 10:00pm daily, unless camping.

**Boat Launch= 1 Launch, 1 Retrieval, and 1 Day Use parking, in the day use area.**

1. Boat Launch users are required to pay the Camping fee for all passenger vehicles and trailers parked in the campground between 10:00pm – 7:00am nightly.

### **Annual Boat Launch Pass Holders:**

Annual Boat Launch Pass holders are responsible for paying the Camping fee for all passenger vehicles and trailers parked in the campground between 10:00pm – 7:00am nightly.

1. The Annual Boat Launch Pass must be firmly affixed to the front driver’s side, 1-foot back from the hitch, of the watercraft trailer or a valid temporary permit/receipt for payment to the State of Alaska must be clearly displayed on the dash of the tow vehicle.
2. Additional Day Use Parking Fees are waived when Launching and Retrieving Daily, between 7:00am – 10:00pm.
3. Camping Fees apply to all Annual Boat Launch Pass holder’s passenger vehicles and trailers parked in designated Camping areas between 10:00pm – 7:00am nightly.

### **Annual Day Pass Holders:**

Annual Day Passes are valid for Day Use only, 7:00am and 10:00pm daily.

1. The Annual Pass must be firmly affixed to the lower corner of the front window, on the driver’s side of the vehicle or a valid temporary permit/receipt for payment to the State of Alaska must be clearly displayed on the dash of the vehicle.
2. Annual Day Pass holders are responsible for Camping Fees when occupants remain in the facility after 10:00pm.

### **Disabled Alaska Veteran Camping Pass (DAV):**

A DAV pass is valid for Camping only.

1. The Disabled Veteran who received the DAV Pass must be Camping with/in the permitted vehicle or RV.
2. Additional passenger vehicles and trailers will be charged the appropriate Boat Launch, Day Use, or Camping Fees.

### **Minimum Length of Stay (LOS):**

Minimum Length of Stay limits may apply to reservations made for the following major holiday weekends; Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, and Labor Day.

*\*Park Fees vary by Facility and are subject to change.*
